University of Northwestern Ohio:

Auto Service Technology - may receive 12 credit hours

Power Equipment Mechanics - may receive 12 credit hours

Associated Builders and Contractors:

Electricity - may receive credit for 1st year of classroom instruction

Carpentry - may receive credit for 1st year of classroom instruction

Stark State College of Technology:

Auto Service Technology - may receive 6 credit hours

Electronics - may receive 12 credit hours

Computer-Aided Engineering - may receive 7 credit hours

Precision Machining - may receive 8 credit hours

Information Technology – may receive 17 credit hours

Graphic Communications – may receive 9 credit hours

Ohio Technical College:

Auto Service Technology - may receive up to 4 courses if taken within the 1st year after graduation

Power Equipment Mechanics - may receive up to 4 courses if taken within the 1st year after graduation

ITT Technical Institute:

Electronics - may receive up to 20 credit hours

Information Technology - may receive up to 12 credit hours

Computer-Aided Engineering - may receive up to 16 credit hours

Kent State University - Trumbull Branch:

Computer-Aided Engineering - may receive up to 7 semester hours

Vatterott College:

Electricity - 48 quarter hours

The University of Akron – Summit College:

Computer-Aided Engineering - may receive up to 9 semester hours

Construction Craft Academy:
