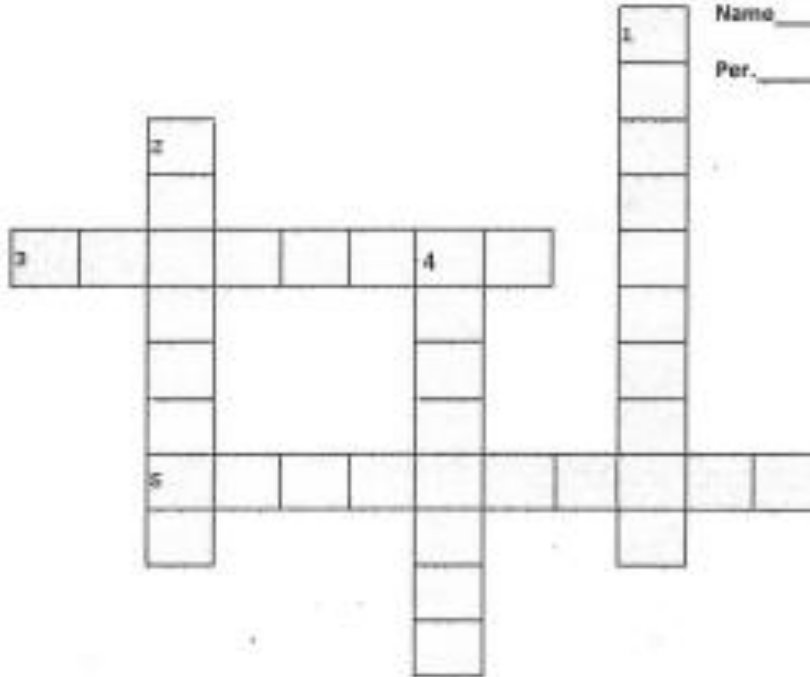
The Department of Labor has an important job of measuring
