**Instructor Objectives:**

1. Students will utilize photographs to identify four different explorers with 100% accuracy.
2. Students will utilize photographs to identify three instruments needed for a basic exam pack with 100% accuracy.
3. Students will utilize photographs to identify two instruments used in amalgam placement with 100% accuracy.
4. Students will utilize photographs to identify two instruments used to carve anatomy into an amalgam restoration with 100% accuracy.

**Method of Instruction:**

Self-study activity

**Activities:**

1. Students will utilize the Instruction sheet to record answers on a piece of paper
  - a. Identify instruments with a short explanation:
    - i. Explorers
    - ii. Mirror
    - iii. Pliers
    - iv. Air/water syringe
    - v. Saliva ejector
    - vi. HVE
    - vii. Surgical aspirator
    - viii. Scalers
    - ix. Currettes
    - x. Amalgam syringe and carrier
    - xi. Amalgam condenser
    - xii. Amalgam carver
    - xiii. Amalgam burnisher
2. Student will list the numbers associated with 4 different types of explorers.
3. Student will list the numbers associated with the instruments that comprise a basic exam pack.

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4. Student will list the numbers associated with 2 instruments utilized in the placement of an amalgam restoration
5. Student will list the numbers associated with 2 instruments utilized in the carving of an amalgam restoration.

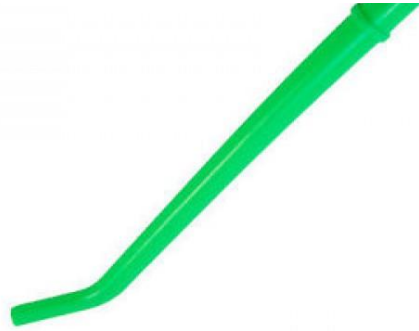

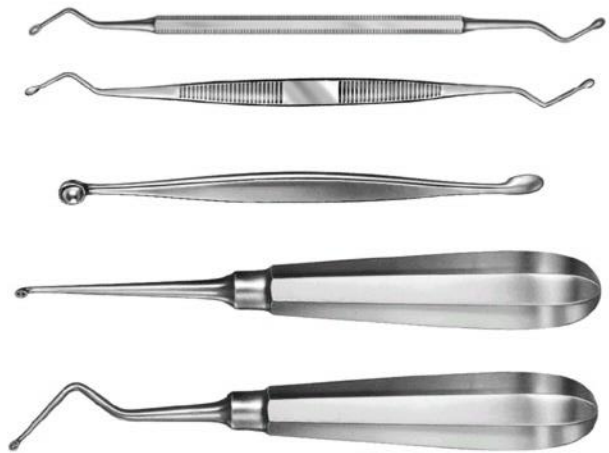
