



Free Meal Expiration

During the pandemic, USDA along with PDE issued a nationwide waiver that approved free meals for all students in K-12 schools to account for unprecedented circumstances. This waiver has been in place since the early onset of the pandemic in 2020 and has now expired as of June 30, 2022. This notification is to inform you that effective the 2022-2023 school year, all school meals will return to free, reduced, or full price.

If your child was Directly Certified through the state or if you were approved for free/reduced meals through a household application this school year, these benefits will carry over 30 days into next school year.
